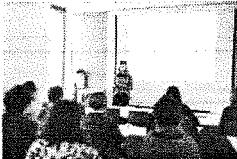


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What is Training Reciprocity


- Required by MDHHS
- Enables training provided by one employer to be accepted by another provider
- Ensures training consistency



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Focus of Training Reciprocity

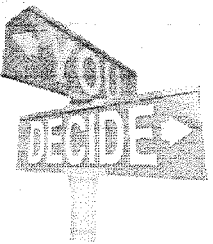

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Utilize your already existing training

1. Gather existing mandatory required training materials (identified on STGW Training Grid)
2. Compare (vet) training tools to applicable Guidelines to ensure all requirements met
3. Utilize 'vetted' existing training materials

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Training Reciprocity Timeline...

- Guideline development & updates will be completed by August 31st
- Vetting tools (for comparing training against Guidelines) will be ready for use September 1st
- Training Reciprocity will be ready to begin rollout early September
- Full implementation expected around April of 2019

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Getting Started with Vetting...

- If Current Curriculum does not meet Guideline req's:
 - Option 1 – Work to update training to meet Guideline(s)
 - Option 2 – Look for existing Vetted training on IMP (recommended)
 - Option 3 – Reach out to STGW for assistance in designing new training
