### <u>Co-occurring Treatment for MAT/OTP Updates – Lisa Miller</u>

- Lisa gave an update of the MI / COD Training Pilot within an OTP Setting
  - Mark and Lisa have been working on the pilot since last June
  - The pilot came about after she noticed disconnects in some of the OTPs that she was working with and phone calls from clients of those programs
    - How to manage comorbidity or co-occurring disorders within the confines of a program that is so hyper-regulated
    - OTPs trying to find ways to do administrative discharges
    - In the Opioid treatment world, things are changing rapidly because of the epidemic and because of the Federal legislative desire to make more and more services available
  - Looking at using MI as a platform and building on it with: COD; Recovery Oriented Care; and focusing more on client interaction
  - Working with the Victory Clinic in Jackson and another clinic in Oakland County
  - They decided to give individual specialized support to: front office; medical; counseling; and supervision staff within the clinic instead of as a group because integrating the staff did not work
  - o It has been a super exciting process as well as very educational

### **Co-occurring College – Jennifer Harrison**

- Changes to the Co-occurring College for FY18
  - o Changes to the COD College; COD activities; and MiFAST
  - o There will be a 2-day Co-occurring College instead of the 1-day event
    - Looking at either June or July for the next college
  - Event to have more of a college feel rather than a conference feel
  - Utilizing the courses from last year and building off of them this year
  - Jennifer developed some materials on the changes and emailed them to the group

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- Mark and Jennifer are hoping this committee will help further develop changes for the college
- New topics and core curriculum classes will be added
  - Day one
    - General education courses taking COD to the next level
    - Core curriculum courses in the area you are working in
    - New assessment measurement tools
      - Incorporating an assessment component using some of the access and fidelity tools to help individuals and teams
        - Self-assessment
        - Internal assessment
        - Leading to a really strong work plan
  - Day two
    - Three specialty topics / courses in the morning
    - Afternoon activities to include team self-assessment
      - Trauma informed care assessment tool
      - Brainstorming scores on assessments
    - Commencement
      - Having the general education course presenter follow-up with commencement activities
      - Transcript / certified courses maybe possible
