## Older Adults:

Most of the older adult responsibilities are being moved to Charlyss Ray, special populations specialist. Workshop, seminar and conference topics targeted toward Community Mental Health providers and affiliates. 'Aphasia and Stroke Related Syndromes' (93% of participants reported gaining new skills and tools to implement in practice) and 'Positive Approaches to Dementia Care' (91% of participants reported gaining new skills and tools to implement in practice) were offered.

### **Assertive Community Treatment:**

As per the Medicaid Provider Manual, Physician's Assistants became eligible to participate in providing psychiatric services to ACT consumers October 1, 2018. The Field Guide to ACT (October 2018 version) has been updated to reflect this change.

#### **ACT team training activities in for 4th quarter 2018:**

- ACT 101 held in Kalamazoo Sept 10 & 11, 2018.
- ACT 201-C Day 2 created for ACT Team Leaders to share and practice new knowledge with their ACT teams in Mt Pleasant.
- Michigan Fidelity Assistance and Support Teams process and development: Training: October 8 & 9, 2018. An outstanding group of experienced and knowledgeable participants whose skills will enhance specific evidence-based practice teams across the state. Training continues to evolve and currently included fidelity reviewers from DBT, COD, IDDT, SE/IPS and ACT for the

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first part of Day 1. Topics included MiFAST overview, reviewer recruitment, etiquette, reviewer process, contract requirements and reimbursement, review details, resources and protocols, tools, interview prompts and specific information on the General Organizational Index and interrater reliability. Day 1 had 30 participating learners.

- Day 2 training focused on ACT teams, ACT/IDDT teams and IDDT teams with instruction on using the MiFAST tool, and critical elements of practices. Day 2 had 9 participating learners.

Significant work continues with the State Training Guidelines Workgroup and the Reciprocity Workgroup. The work continues; current accomplishments: STGW have been providing information and training across the state and at Outcomes Conferences related to direct care staff; currently 27 agencies have signed up to use the transcription function to assign learning to workers.

Course development and redevelopment continues; new and redeveloped materials meet the WCAG 2.0AA accessibility standards and are tagged with an accessibility logo; coursework meeting the State Training Guideline Workgroup curriculum and vetting standards are tagged with a STGW logo. New courses: Limited English Proficiency, Infection Control (both live), Cultural Competency, Recipient Rights annual review, HIPAA Basic and Comprehensive, LOCUS and Substance Use Disorders are in final developmental stage. The site will undergo a planned revision and update during fiscal year 19, based upon user feedback to enhance the user experience.
