





LOCUS Dimensional Average Scores


Over time, first time MiFAST reviews are averaging very similar scores.







- SUCCESS! By the end of FY22, 98% of CMHs in Michigan has had a MiFAST Review! Only one remains!
- PIHP Regions differ in size, number of CMHs, number of individuals served, and number of subcontractors (as applicable). Therefore, the number of reviews conducted within each PIHP Region will vary.

Dimensional Averages: Comments

- Dimensional averages have maintained consistency over time.
- High scoring dimensions have been seen with implementation related dimensions such as LOCUS completion, Program Support, Timeliness, and Person-centered Planning.
- Lower scoring dimensions have been related to Process and Outcome monitoring as well as Quality and Supervision.
- Based on feedback from fidelity reviews and training evaluations, the lower scoring dimensions continue to be areas of consultation and support requests.



Dimensional Averages: Planning



- COVID significantly impacted the LOCUS Project due to organizational reprioritization.
- Lower scoring dimensions have already resulted in development and implementation of other training opportunities such as webinars, trainer cohort, etc.
- FY22 started the process of completing second MiFAST reviews with organizations. Lapeer CMH was the first organization to do a 2nd review and demonstrated significant positive changes!
- Scheduling of 2nd reviews and/or providing Technical Assistance is a FY23 priority!
- While the first several years of the project focused more on implementation, getting LOCUS up and running, the next phase will emphasize quality/outcomes management holistically.
